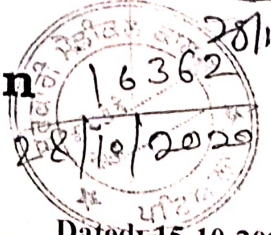

This is in with regard to your application for approval / permission to Government Medical College, Patiala for the award of MBBS Degree granted by Baba Farid University of Faridkot against for the increased intake i.e. from 150 - 200 seats submitted u/s-11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 submitted to now dissolved Board of Governors in Supersession of the Medical Council of India. It is brought to your notice that the Central Government has on 24th September 2020 notified the NMC Act, 2019 fully. Section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 provides as under:

*"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, the educational standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under:"*


2. Accordingly your application was processed u/s 11(2)/10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 and Establishment of New Medical Colleges Regulations, 1999. I am directed to convey the approval / permission against increased intake from 150-200 student for the academic year 2020-21 **(One year only)** by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) of the National Medical Commission to Government Medical College, Patiala u/s 11(2)/10(A) of the IMC Act, 2019 read with section 61(2) of NMC Act, 2019.

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The permission is subject to:

- (i) The submission of undertaking from State Govt. towards rectification of deficiencies.
- (i) Establishment of BSL-II lab for testing of Covid-19 patient.
3. Further you are also permitted to continue your intake of increase in MBBS seats from 200-225 granted under EWS quota for 2019-20.
4. The next batch of students in the MBBS course shall be admitted only after permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission for renewal/recognition as per regulations that would be framed under section 26 and 28 of the NMC Act, 2019.
5. The Government Medical College (except those located in Union Territory of J&K) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal of permission is granted for all India Quota.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under NMC Act and regulations made there under.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board and the State Government.
8. The communication regarding recognition of the MBBS Degree will follow.
9. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.


